– your paper drawn up in accordance with the requirements. The file name should contain the author's name(s) and the section number, e.g. Paper_Sidorov_Ivanova_Section 1. The paper can be written by either one author or a group (not more than three people).

– expert opinion on open publication possibility;
– a scan of your consent to personal data processing;
– a scan of your consent to publishing an electronic version of full text/metadata of the paper.

Participation and publication of the conference materials is free of charge. the Call for Papers, with paper originality below 75%, with inappropriate borrowings, sent after the deadline.

GENERAL SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

Heading, abstract, key words, authors' affiliation (in Russian and English).

UDC PAPER SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

(font size 14, abbreviations should be avoided)
the author's (authors') name(s), scientific degree: lowercase, center alignment
the university name: lowercase, italics, center alignment;

Abstract (250- 1050 characters, spaces included)

Key words (5-7 words or phrases)

The text of the paper should be in A4 paper format in portrait orientation: margins: bottom – 2.5 cm; top, left and right – 2 cm, single line space, indentation size – 1.25 cm, type: Times New Roman, font size 14.

The figures should be jpg-formatted. All figures should have picture captions located under the figure and containing the number, title of the figure and legend keys (if any). The picture captions should be separated from the figure, with center alignment.

If you use a figure from the Internet, the picture captions should include the source, e.g.:

The numbers and titles of the tables should be located above the tables, alignment justified. You should use “Times New Roman” font, size – 12 in the tables.

Formula expressions are written only in a formula editor (MathType or EquationEditor). In formulae Latin letters and Greek lowercase letters should be

written in italics while Greek capital letters upright. Alignment is central.

The paper should not end with an illustration or a table.

The paper length is from 5 to 10 pages (1 page = 1800 characters without spaces, the number of pages is rounded up to a whole number).

There is no page numbering.

Only units, abbreviations, symbols accepted in the international system of measures, physical, chemical and mathematical quantities and terms can be used.

In the paper only printing quotes (« ») should be used. Shortenings and abbreviations should be the same throughout the text.

REFERENCES

We encourage you to include works having DOIs in your references.

Citation is sequential, by order of citation. The reference numbers are given in square brackets. The references should be built up according to ГОСТ Р 7.0.100-2008 “Bibliographic record. Bibliographic description. General requirements and rules”.
